I like to chuck some of the 'other' tables that are sitting on the website, as a result of the stats and data I'm collecting for our competition.

Here I've copied 'My' Premier League Table.

It takes into account not only the results, but who the teams have played, and the relevant handicaps that were set for the teams at the beginning of the season.

Guess the most noticeable differences are the City and Arsenal positions, especially Woolwich's.

Actually comparing this to the Perpetual League Table I also run, makes interesting reading (well I think so).

Forest are actually only 2 points better off in the 10 games they've played this season, than last. Liverpool & City have the same points from the 10 games.

Chelsea are the most improved, 7 more points than the same 10 games last time. Brighton have 6 points more, Bournemouth 5.

Wolves have the worst start, -9 points, whilst Palace are on -6 and Man United and Villa on -5.
