

## Season 24/25 - Newsletter 30

Newcastle 3 Wolves 0 became our SECOND best predicted scoreline this season, delivering a massive 555.33 points for us all, with 3 Correct Guaranteed, and 6 Correct Enhanced Bankers. Manchester City's 3-1 win at West Ham earlier in the season remains out in front.

And then the late United show delivered 463.90 points, to become the FIFTH highest scoring game. It was a high scoring round.

There were still THREE negative scores this round, but we averaged 26.80.
