


All Fans will face each other twice in the season, with a Cup Competition in the new year. The scores will update the Fans Table as the goals go in.

The link to the Engine Room can be found at the bottom of the DashBoard, and here data can be seen on the games being played in The Picks, as well as 'The 12', and data for Players taking part in those games we've named in our Picks. I mentioned this in the first Newsletter, and have grabbed some screenshots whilst the games during this weekend were going on to give it a bit more meaning.





The Tables Tab in the menu will also give you access to full Tables for The Picks, The Grand Prix Trophy, The Scores Per Round and The Guesswork.

Guesswork is where the guesses from all of us will be shown, once the Round goes live. You will also have a copy of your own guesswork recorded on your own Dash page. When received it will show here your predictions are in, if not in then they will register as "X".



As mentioned previously, The British Heart Foundation has benefitted from the competition sign ups this time round. As has been the way over the last couple of years a percentage of all signing on fees, and any additional donations will go to the charity.
